- **Amáda Márquez Simula (House District 39B).** Márquez Simula advances to the general election with a community-first campaign focused on giving working families a voice in Saint Paul.
- **Angie Hanson (MN Senate District 23).** Hanson moves forward to November committed to standing up for her community and fighting for fair wages, healthcare access, and civil rights.
